FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS(FAQS)

- a. How can someone apply for a Mt. Zion scholarship? Go to Mt. Zion's website at mtzioncleveland.com and click on the "Ministries and Outreach" tab. All necessary information for you to complete will be under "Mt. Zion Scholarships."
- b. Who is eligible to apply for the Mt. Zion Congregational Church, United Church of Christ Scholarships? Any member of Mt. Zion in good standing can apply for a scholarship.
- c. Who can apply for the Colynn Shinn Scholarship? Any Mt. Zion member who is a senior attending Shaker Heights High School and any non-member who is a senior attending Shaker Heights High School.
- d. Who can apply for the Benjamin F. Lindsay, Jr. Scholarship? Any Mt. Zion member who is a High School senior and any High School senior in the greater Cleveland area who will major in and aspires to have a career in the health care field.
- e. Who can apply for the scholarships administered by Mt. Zion's Christian Business League? Any student who meets the eligibility requirements outlined in each scholarship are eligible to apply.
- f. As a member of Mt. Zion, would I be eligible to apply for a scholarship if I were pursuing an Associate degree or trade degree? Yes, you would be eligible to apply.
- g. What is the general amount of your scholarship award? Awardees receive a \$1000 scholarship. The Benjamin Lindsay Scholarship award is decided upon by its executor.
- h. *Are any of your scholarships renewable?* Mt. Zion Scholarships are not renewable with the exception of the Benjamin F. Lindsay Scholarship and the Samuel G. & Bobbie Ruth Sadler Scholarship. Scholarships managed by Mt. Zion's Christian Business League are renewable.
- i. Are any of your scholarships available to students who aren't high school seniors? Yes. Scholarships managed by the Christian Business League provide renewable scholarships to students currently enrolled in college. Information about scholarships managed by Mt. Zion's Christian Business League can be found on mtzioncleveland.com under the link Ministries and Outreach.

- j. What is the deadline for the scholarship? The electronic deadline for the 2019 scholarship is May 22. The postmark deadline for scholarship applications is 11:59pm on May 20, 2019.
- k. How and when do I receive my scholarship? Upon receipt of the admission letter from your college and proof of your intention of enrollment, ie. Housing assignment, class schedule, etc., the Scholarship Committee Chairperson will process the request for your scholarship award check.
